



# Feet of Clay

## Artist-in-Residence program announcement

### *Mission of the artist-in-residency program:*

To support the ceramic arts and to build the Feet of Clay community by establishing an Artist in Residence program that will fund a ceramic artist and grant one year of free membership starting from June 2012 to May of 2013.

### *Residency includes:*

- semi-private membership which includes large shelving unit
- 24 hour access to the studio
- opportunity to teach adult classes

### *Residency requirements:*

- Give two day-long workshops to Feet of Clay Members during course of residency
- Give one slideshow of their previous works or experiences, or works in progress
- Artist is also required to participate in the Feet of Clay Show and Sales in April and December
- artists are expected to spend a minimum of 10 hours per week in the studio
- fire their own work
- artists are required to work three hours per month doing studio operations
- Not included: materials, firing costs and show fee

### *Application Process:*

Applications are due by January 31, 2012. To apply, please send a resume, up to five digital photographs of your work and a cover letter describing your interest and how you expect to contribute to our community to Feet of Clay, c/o Jenn Wyman, 21 Station Street, Brookline, MA 02445.

### *Prerequisites:*

Any ceramic artist, including current Feet of Clay members, will be considered for the Artist in Residence program. Teaching experience is not necessary. Applicants should have the ability to work independently, and possess an enthusiasm and willingness to be part of the Feet of Clay community!
